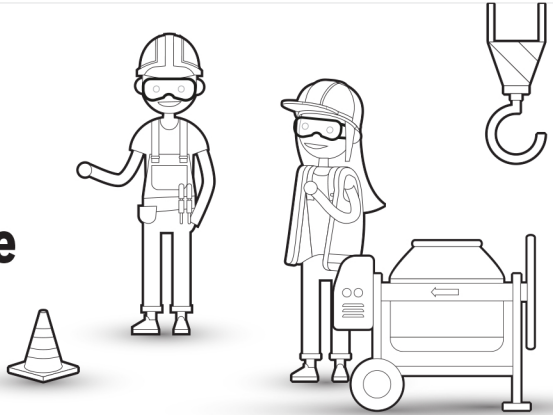


Millennials face the highest risk of workplace eye injuries



40% Not only do millennials represent the largest share of America's workforce, they are also **40% more likely to get injured** than their older colleagues.

millennial (n): a person born in the 1980s or 1990s



More than 1 in 3 workers are a millennial

47% of the U.S. workforce is **female**, yet ... **>3X men** experience **more eye injuries** than women⁴ (incident rate among men is 3.2; women 1.1)

Leading causes of injuries include

- Objects striking, scraping or penetrating the eye
- Chemical or thermal burns
- Lack of compliance is leading cause of eye injuries

90% of eye injuries **could be avoided by wearing the proper eye protection**
